

Independent Directors' Familiarization Programme

PREAMBLE

Regulation 25 (7) of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 stipulates that the company shall familiarise the independent directors through various programs about their roles, rights and responsibilities in the company, nature of the industry in which the company operates, business model of the company, etc.

OUTLINE OF THE FAMILIARISATION PROCESS

Independent Directors of the Company are made aware of their role, rights & responsibilities at the time of their appointment, through a formal letter of appointment, which also stipulates various terms and conditions of their engagement.

The Board including all Independent Directors are being provided with relevant documents, reports and internal policies to enable them to familiarise with the Company's procedures and practices from time to time.

Periodic presentations are made at the Board and Board Committee Meetings, on business and performance updates of the Company, business strategy and risks involved.

Updates on relevant statutory changes concerning the Company are informed to the entire Board on regular intervals.
